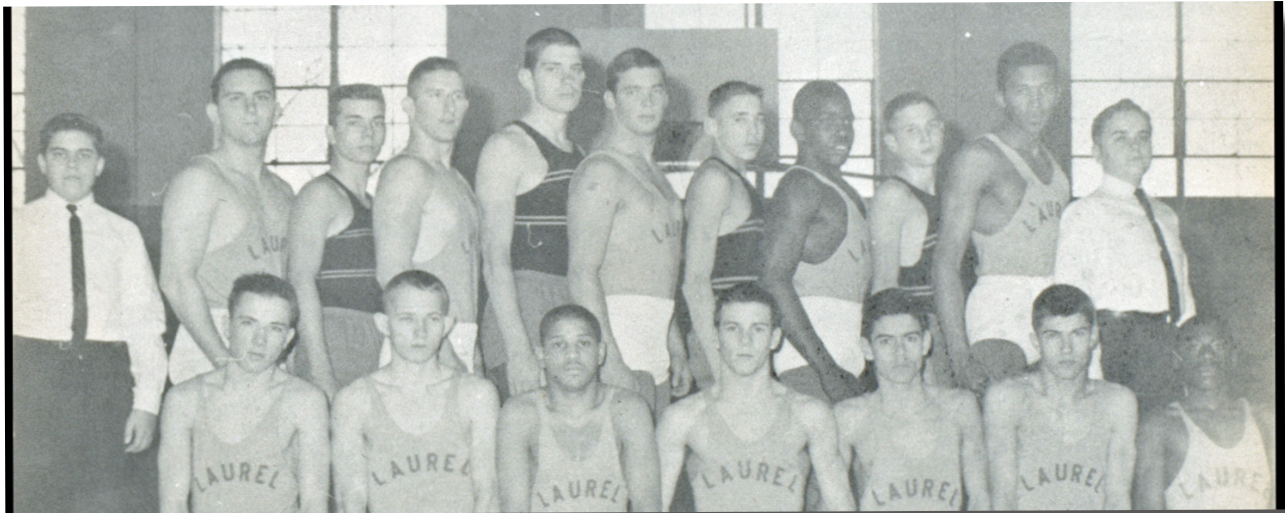


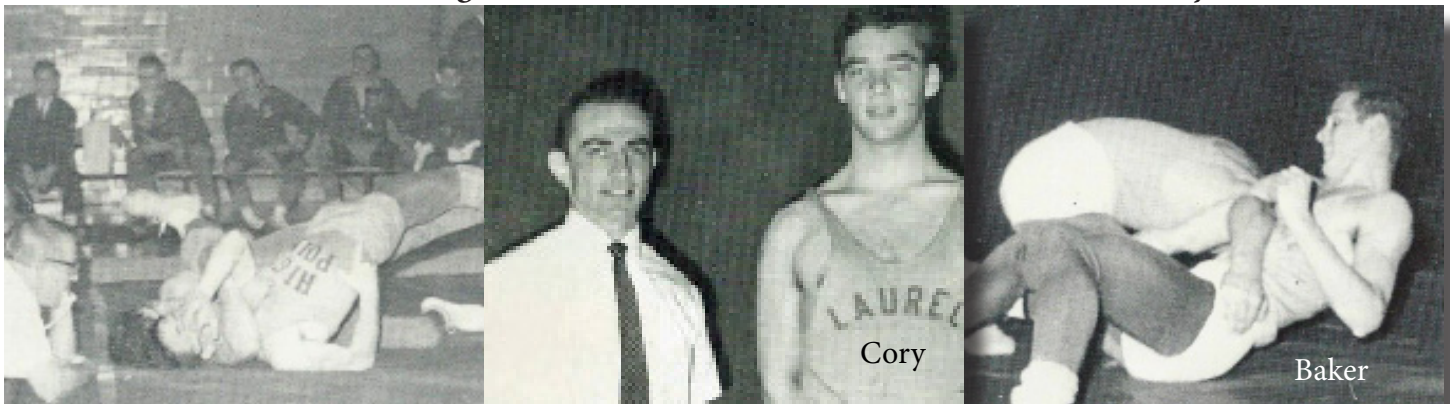

# South Hagerstown Grapplers Capture Tournament Title

South Hagerstown High School captured the 13th annual Metropolitan Invitational Wrestling Tournament in Hyattsville over the weekend.

The Rebels, one of 15 teams competing and the lone entrant from the Hagerstown area, scored 75 points. Annapolis was second with 67 and Severna Park third with 63.

This was only the fourth time that coach Bill Debolt's grapplers had entered the tourney won last year by Northwood.

The nationally recognized event is the nearest thing to a state tournament with four counties being represented.
